Requirements to work as a Pharmacy Technician in the State of North Dakota

You must complete one of the following:

- Participate in and graduate from an ASHP (American Society of Health-System Pharmacists) approved Pharmacy Technician Program
- Or, participate in an ASHP approved Pharmacy Technician Tech-In-Training program (once enrolled, you must register as a Pharmacy Technician in training with the North Dakota Board of Pharmacy in order to work in a pharmacy)
- Upon completion and/or graduation of one of the above, you must pass an approved national certification exam. You are now eligible to apply for registration as a pharmacy technician with the North Dakota State Board of Pharmacy
